

## 1.2.1 Health & Safety Rules

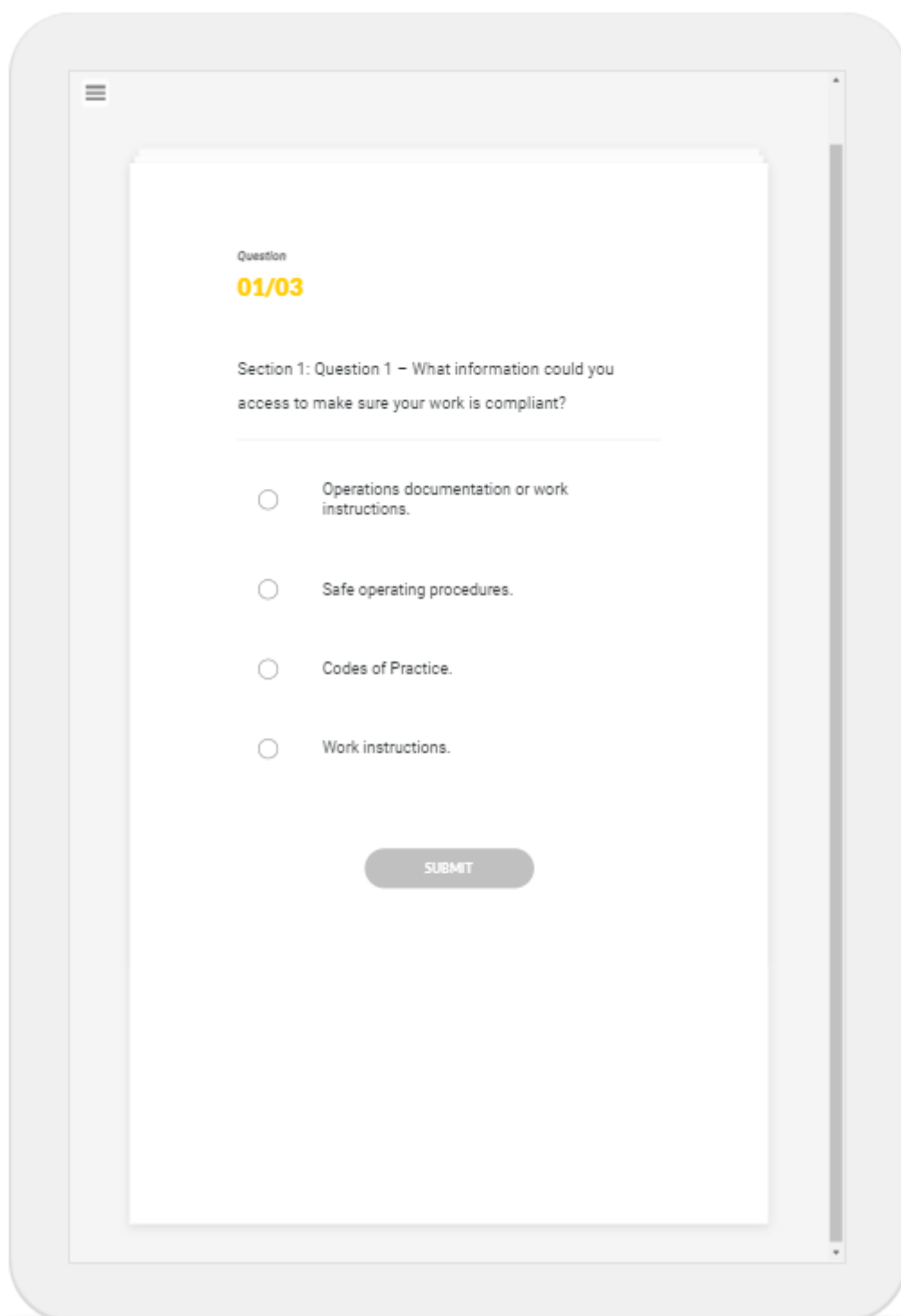
Every workplace has to follow laws and rules to keep everyone safe. There are 4 main types:
